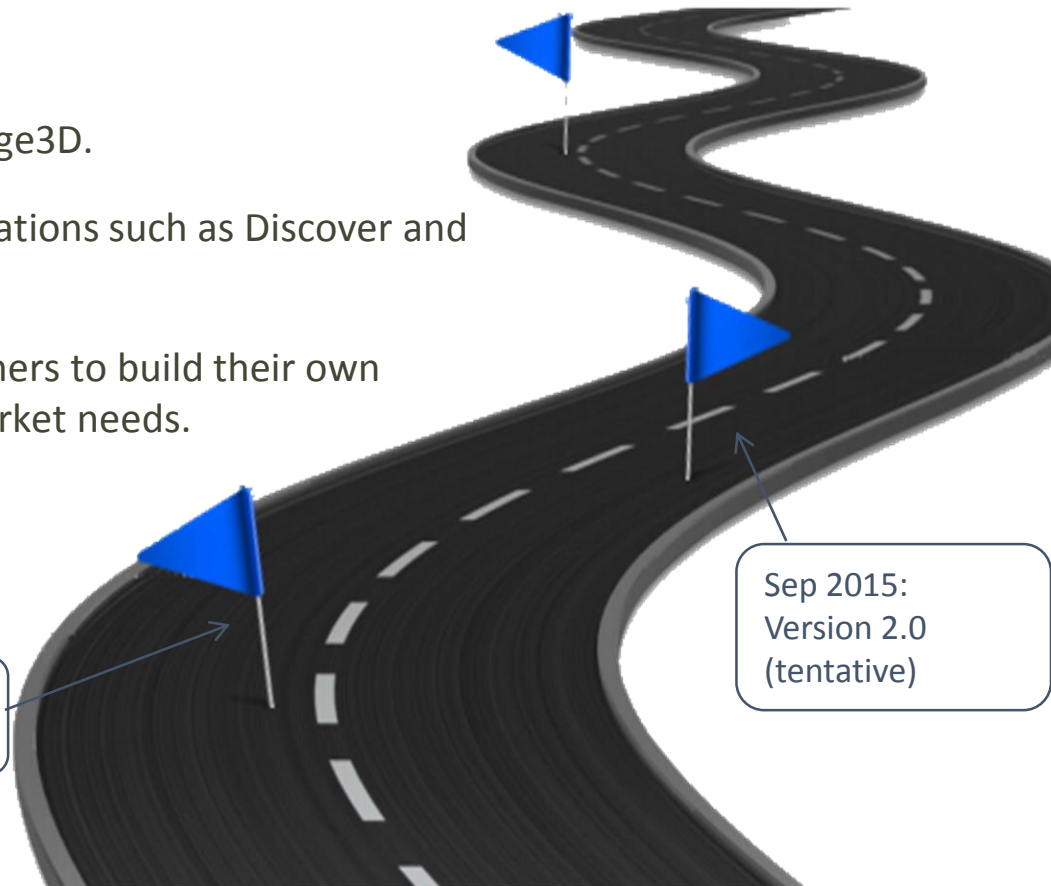
New Possibilities
